EDU Ranking Spain 2018 How to get to Guadalajara, Spain

The EDU Ranking Spain 2018 will be organized on November 23 & 24, 2018, in Guadalajara, which is just under 50Km from the main airport of Madrid (Adolfo Suarez). It will be held in "Palacio Multiuso" which is located at Avenida del Vado No 13, 19005 Guadalajara.

Guadalajara is about 35 minutes' drive from Madrid airport, but there are two traditional options to go from the airport to Guadalajara using public transport. The easiest for tourists is to take the Metro from the airport to the Nuevos Ministerios station, which is about 15 minutes ride, and then take a train "C2" to Guadalajara. The train takes about 1 hour and 10 minutes, and there are about 4 trains per hour. The other option is to take a bus, Number 200, from the airport to the bus station at Avenida de America, which takes about 20 minutes, from where there is a non-stop bus to Guadalajara, "Alsa L6", which takes about 55 minutes. There is a bus about every 20 minutes. The bus is a bit cheaper than the train: the buses will cost less than 5€ and the Metro and train less than 10€.

A more modern method would involve using Uber or Cabify, both of which work well in Madrid.

A block booking has been made at Hotel Tryp Guadalajara, which is a **** star hotel. The rate that has been agreed for the tournament is 40€/Person/Day in a double room with breakfast (70€ for single room, 37€ for triple room), but to get this rate you must arrange the booking by sending an email to PILAR@VIAJESBERTIOGA.com, which is the travel agent that has made the booking.

Transport from the airport to Guadalajara can be arranged, but only for groups. If you are interested in this service, please send an email to the same address, specifying how many people you think will be in your group and the time of arrival and departure, and the agency can get a price quote for the service.
