In all events in which there are more than one level it is assumed that the international players will only be permitted to participate in the highest categories, unless it has been agreed otherwise beforehand. This will depend on the reliability of the player statistics applied in each country.

## INTERNATIONAL TEAM CHAMPIONSHIP

Categories A and B: Mixed scoresheet Cricket and 501 DO
Categories C and D: Mixed scoresheet Cricket and 501 AO
Scoresheet with 7 games on the winner's side and 5 games on the loser's side. It is not necessary to complete the entire scoresheet; the first team to achieve 4 games on the winner's side and 3 games on the loser's side wins. The 501 games will be played using two scores, applying the freeze rule, and the cricket games will be played with both players of a team using the same score.
Entry fee: $100 €$ per team
All teams must be pre-registered

## Summary of the Rules and Procedures

1. All registrations for each event must be carried out using one of the kiosks that are available in the tournament hall. The registration requires a player card which has a barcode. For players who do not have such a player card, a temporary version printed on paper can be obtained on request from the control station.
2. No players can be participating in more than one event at the same time.
3. In the case of single and double matches, the score sheet, which should always stay in the display at the control station until the end of the match, must be signed by the winner of the match in the corresponding box, and handed in to be processed.
4. In the case of team events the score sheet should be taken to the darts board, but must never leave the tournament hall. At the end of the match it must be signed by the captains of both teams, after which the captain of the winning team should sign in the corresponding box on the part of the scoresheet which is found on the reverse side of the scoresheet, in a similar manner as is used for singles events.
5. The tournament management will not be held responsible for errors in the completion of the core sheets (for instance signing in the loser's box instead of the winner's box).
6. Players must report to their darts boards as soon as their game has been called. A player can have a second call after five minutes, and if he still does not present himself at the board within five minutes of the second call he will be eliminated. In the case of team events, a team which has been called twice (start of the match and a second call) will lose one game every five minutes until they are eliminated, or present themselves to play the remaining games. In the case of a team which has already lost one match due to not being present, it can be eliminated directly five minutes after the second call, without waiting five minutes for each game.
7. All the scoresheets must include the ranking data of the match (PPD or MPR) as shown by the darts machine. In the case of a scoresheet that includes some false data (such as incorrect PPD, incorrect player ID, etc), the players or teams responsible will be expelled from the tournament.
8. If a player deletes the display of the ranking data before it has been written down on the scoresheet, by pushing the player change button too early, he will lose the game, or if he was the loser, will lose the next game. In the case of teams, the team of the player which deleted the display will lose a game (the current one if they were the winners or the next if they were already the losers).
9. Teams which present less than 4 players cannot play, and will be eliminated.
10. In the case of time constraints, in team events the tournament director may assign two darts boards to a match, in which case they must both be used simultaneously.
11. The maximum time allowed for a match is 30 minutes in the case of singles and doubles, and one hour in the case of teams. After this time the winner of the match will be decided with reference to the points obtained.
12. The tournament management reserves the right to modify the published timings of the events.
13. The International players should ensure that they are included in the database, otherwise they will not be able to register for any events.
14. Players must be able to show official ID (passports, ID cards, driving license, etc). If the identity of a player is to be checked, it must be done before the start of the match. A team that requests to check the ID of their opponent during a match will forfeit two games.
